### Inspiration Board

#### What are you doing?

You will create an inspiration board to express your interests in photography and your personal style. This will serve as something to inspire you to create art.

#### Why is it important?

Before starting a project, artists, photographers and designers usually start by pulling inspiration from photos and compiling them into a clean and cohesive inspiration board. This step is fundamental to the creative process, and it has proven to be effective time and time again for helping students come up with original concepts.

#### How are you graded?

This counts as a project grade. You are graded on your use of the elements of art (see attached) and the completion of the following list.

#### Your inspiration board must have the following parts

- Cut paper/magazine photos (10 points)
- Personal Photos taken by you (10 points)
- Texture- Cloth/fabric/found objects (10 points)
- Text-Either hand written, typed and cut out (10 points)
- Overlapping images (10 points)
- Good Craftsmanship-Neat gluing/cutting (10 points)
- Creative use of -line, shape, color, texture, pattern, and space (30 points)
- Hand in on time with name on back and experience survey filled out (*see reverse*) (10 points)
